In that case, the position of trainer in the UvA Visible Learning Trajectories Programme at the UvA Teaching and Learning Centre - Centraal might be a perfect fit!

By using the Learning Trajectory methodology, which forms the basis of the Visible Learning Trajectories Programme, several learning trajectory teams - consisting of the programme director and the learning trajectory coordinators - work towards the optimal alignment of course objectives, learning trajectory objectives and exit qualifications of a degree programme, in a total of five meetings.

The cohesion and structure of all objectives are visualised, analysed and optimised by determining which course objectives and exit qualifications link to which learning trajectory, and how the aimed learning trajectory goals can be achieved. The eventual outcome of this process is visualised in the Visible Learning Trajectories tool.

What are you going to do?

From the UvA Teaching and Learning Center we are looking for UvA-colleagues who would like to play a role in the Visible Learning Trajectories Programme as trainer for a total of 0,2 FTE, besides their original position within the UvA as senior lecturer, education developer, or quality officer. The current trainer team of the Visible Learning Trajectories Programme consists of 12 trainers.

Each semester, you will guide 2 degree programmes through the Visible Learning Trajectories methodology, together with another trainer. You will guide this process from the start - an intake meeting with the programme director - to the final analysis of the curriculum. For each degree programme, you will guide a total of 5 learning trajectory meetings and give both substantive guidance and facilitate process management to the learning trajectory teams - for example by meeting in smaller groups in between the meetings or by giving feedback on the learning trajectories, learning trajectory goals or exit qualifications formulated by the learning trajectory teams.





What do you have to offer?

The trainer we are looking for...

- has an academic background;
- is available for a minimum of 0.2 FTE, for at least one year;
- has been educated in the field of education or has earned an STQ-certificate;
- has experience in curriculum design and implementation and has knowledge of quality systems;
- has knowledge on and experience with guiding education innovation or education design programmes;
- can be an inspiration and be a motivator for teacher teams and is able to listen carefully;
- wants to continue learning new things in the field of education;
- can look at the structure of curricula from different points of view;
- can switch between the frames of reference of different teacher teams;
- looks for a connection both within and beyond the team and is also able to work independently.

What can we offer you?

We offer temporary employment on the basis of an internal secondment for 0.2 to 0.4 FTE for the period of at least one year, or until the end of the project (May 2025). The position is for 8 to 16 hours a week.

Your salary will be between €4.538 to €5.826 a month (gross) based on a fulltime work week of 38 hours, depending on relevant experience at the start of employment. This number excludes an 8% holiday allowance and an 8.3% end-of-the-year allowance. The <u>CLA of Dutch Universities</u> applies to this position.
