What to do when the slow-whoop sounds

- Stay calm and order the others to stay calm. Count the people in the room.
- Pack your (easy to carry) stuff and tell the students to do the same. (leave alle heavy and big items to carry in the room)
- Close all windows and doors
- Leave the building through escape routes
- Take the class to a meeting point
 - Roetersweiland / Green nose / grassfield near REC G
 - Behind REC E or in REC E
 - In front of REC M





Teacher Responsibilities in the Classroom

- In life-threatening situations, call **112** immediately
- Also call **020 525 2222** (internal emergency number)
- Tell the operator what is happening and where you are.
- Evacuate the classroom if necessary
- Provide first aid if necessary
- Assist emergency response staff (first aid / emergency team) when needed

What do you need to Know?

- know the building plans and where you are
- know the emergency exits
- Know where the Firehoses and EHBO materials are
